

## Business and Labor Law

In this module the students shall learn the basic concepts and theoretical contributions regarding business activities and relations binding two parties, the object of legal relations, the content of legal transactions and liabilities, rights and duties of the parties entering into a contract, methods and procedures for undertaking business activities and their applications.

The module places huge emphasis on the student's ability to acquire the related knowledge relating to economic problems and to find a practical solution by thinking creatively and in a critical way. Business law will be used as a helpful instrument for describing and solving legal and economic problems, thus offering expertise in defining and applying terms of a contract whilst studying different types of contracts.
