This Module aims to provide a practical and legal background to the nature and function of the Conflict of Laws and the international institutional and convention rules and regulations of dispute resolution to enable graduates to apply these principles in a professional and competent manner in international dispute resolution processes. In this module the students shall acquire the basic concepts of National laws as the primary sources of private international law. However, there is no well-defined body of private international law. Private international law deals with a variety of topics, such as contracts, marriage and divorce, jurisdiction, recognition of judgments, child adoption and abduction, and many other areas.
